




Stainless Steel Trash Pans




Stainless Steel Trash Pan Splice



Trash Pan Hardware










Install the *TOP AUGER TRASH SPREADER PAN* under the top auger at the fill end of the dryer. The pan covers the first four columns from this end. Follow these instructions for proper placement.


Top Auger Trash Spreader Pan Installation

- 1. Begin by starting on the fill end of the dryer, under the first safety handrail mounting bracket, by drilling a 3/8" hole at the dimple location (see fig. A).
- 2. Using the hole pattern of the <u>longest</u> trash pan in the kit and the dimples on the top auger trough side as guidelines, drill the rest of the holes for the first trash pan section.
- 3. If a splice pan is included in the kit, drill a 3/8" hole 16" from the center of the last hole drilled. Using the last hole drilled as first hole of the second trash pan, use dimples to drill 3/8" holes to match the hole pattern of the second longest trash pan section.
- 4. If a second splice pan is included in the kit, drill a 3/8" hole 16" from the center of the last hole. Using the last hole drilled as first hole of trash pan, use dimples to drill 3/8" holes to match the hole pattern of the shortest trash pan in the kit.
- 5. After all the holes for the trash pan brackets are drilled bolt the brackets to the trash pan sections. If your kit has more than one section do not bolt the bracket at the splice end to the trash pans until they have been mounted in the auger housing. After trash pans are in place then lay your splice in the gap between the sections and then bolt the remaining brackets to the assembly. Remember that the longest trash pan section starts at the fill end of the dryer then the next longest and so on. Refer to the photographs on the next page to help you assemble the trash pan section.

(NOTE: The photographs showing the splice installed before the assembly has been put in the dryier are for reference. Splice the trash pan sections together after they have bolted into the auger housing as described in step 5.)





Trash pan and brackets bolted together. View of bottom side of trash pan.
