

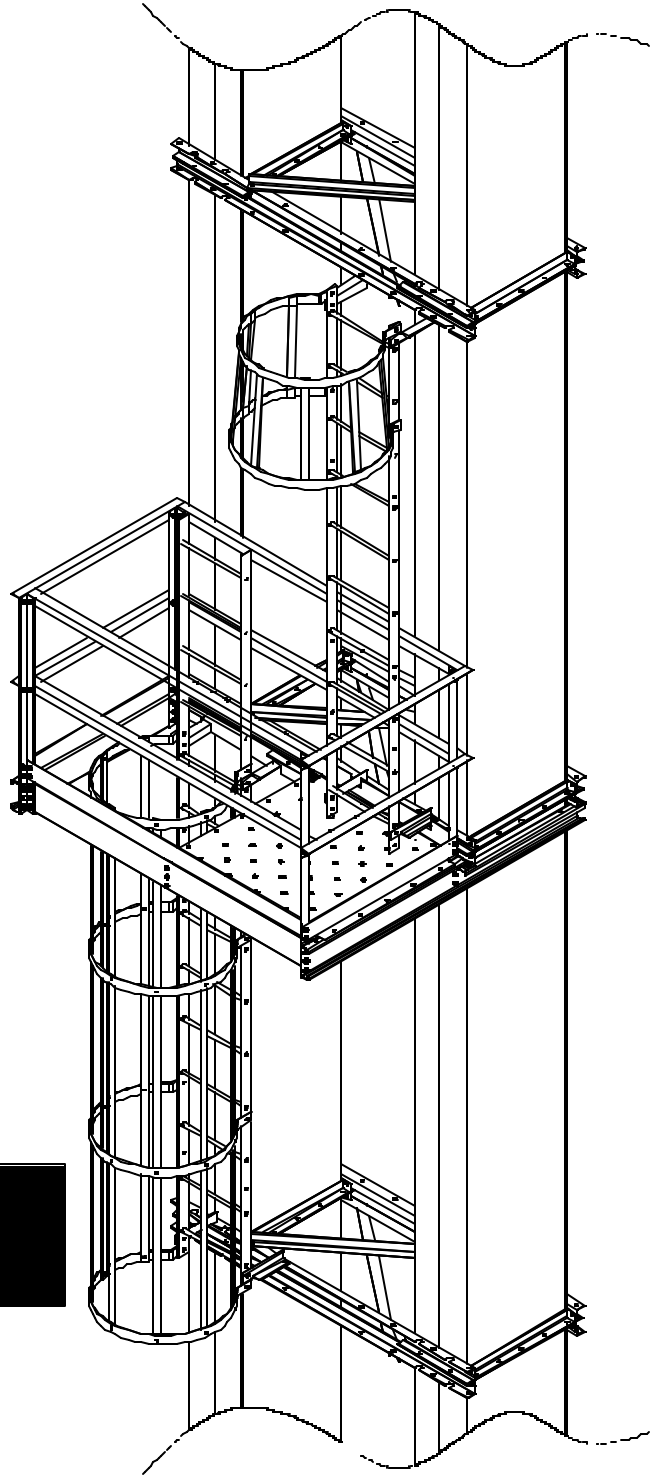

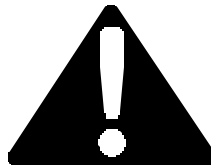

CAUTION indicates a potentially hazardous situation which, if not avoided, may result in minor or moderate injury.



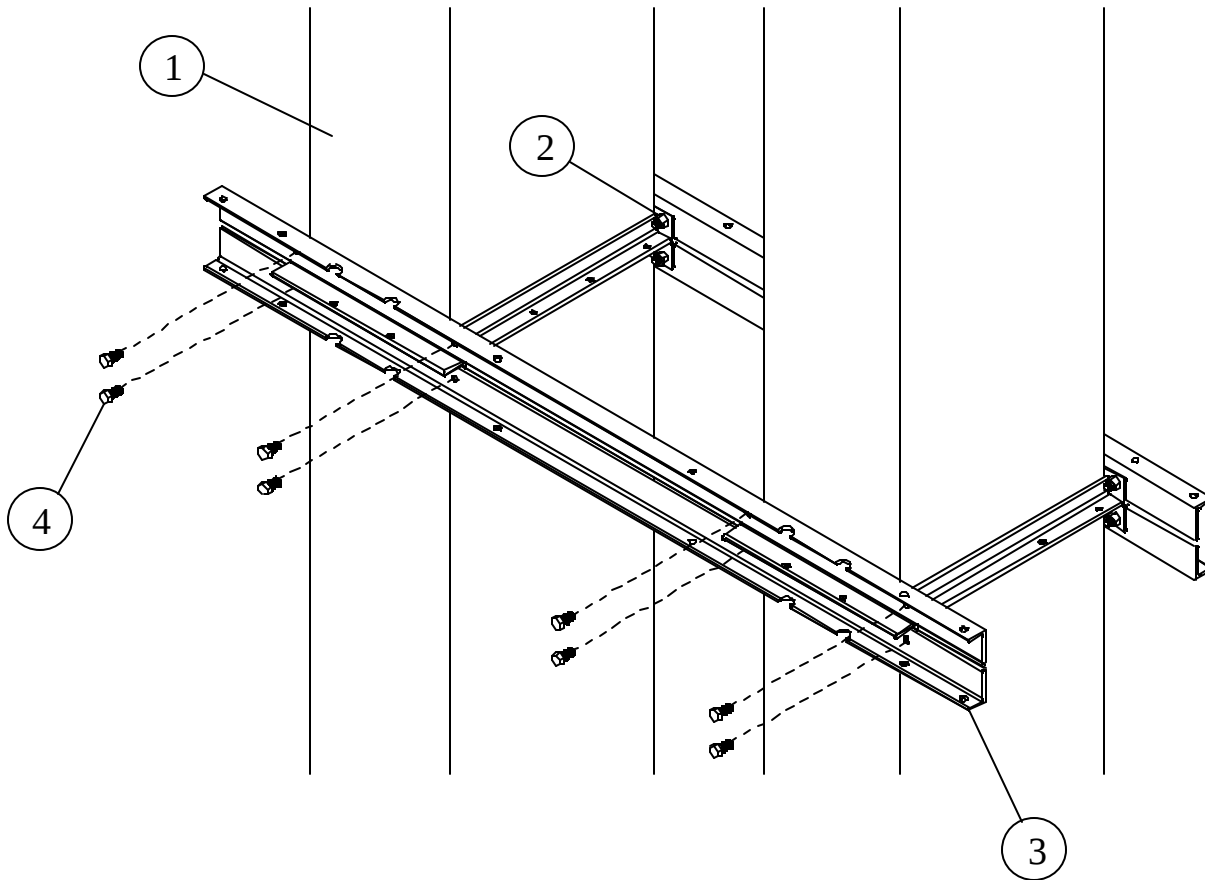

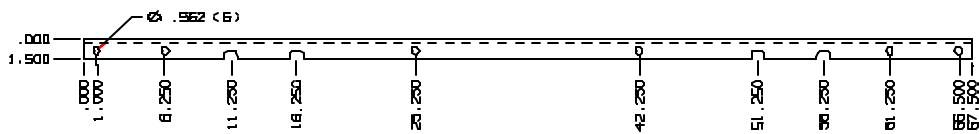
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Attach the up and down legs together with the tie angles. Position the tie angles as shown and fasten with the 1/2"-13x1" bolts.

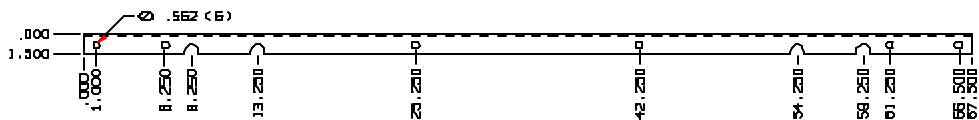


1. Trunking Section

4. 1/2"-13x1" Hex Bolt

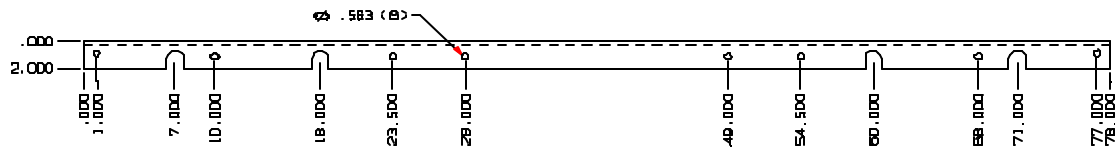
BECT3040 30" Elevator Tie Angle



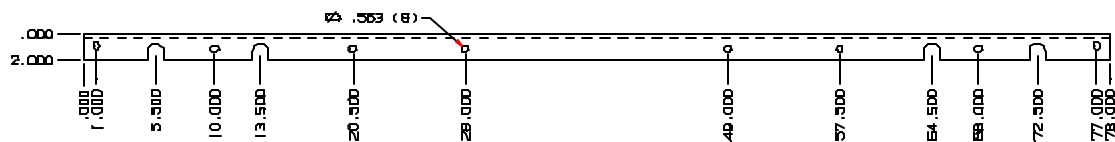
BECT3011 36" Elevator Tie Angle



BECT4211 42" Elevator Tie Angle

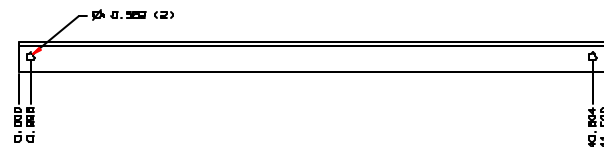


BECT4804 48" Elevator Tie Angle

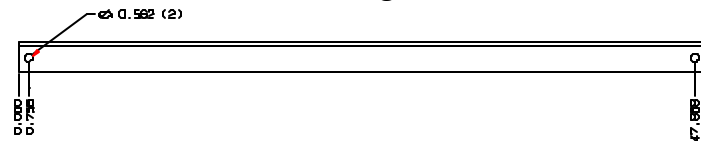


The 42" and 48" elevators have cross braces that brace the two tie angles diagonally. (one per pair of tie angles)

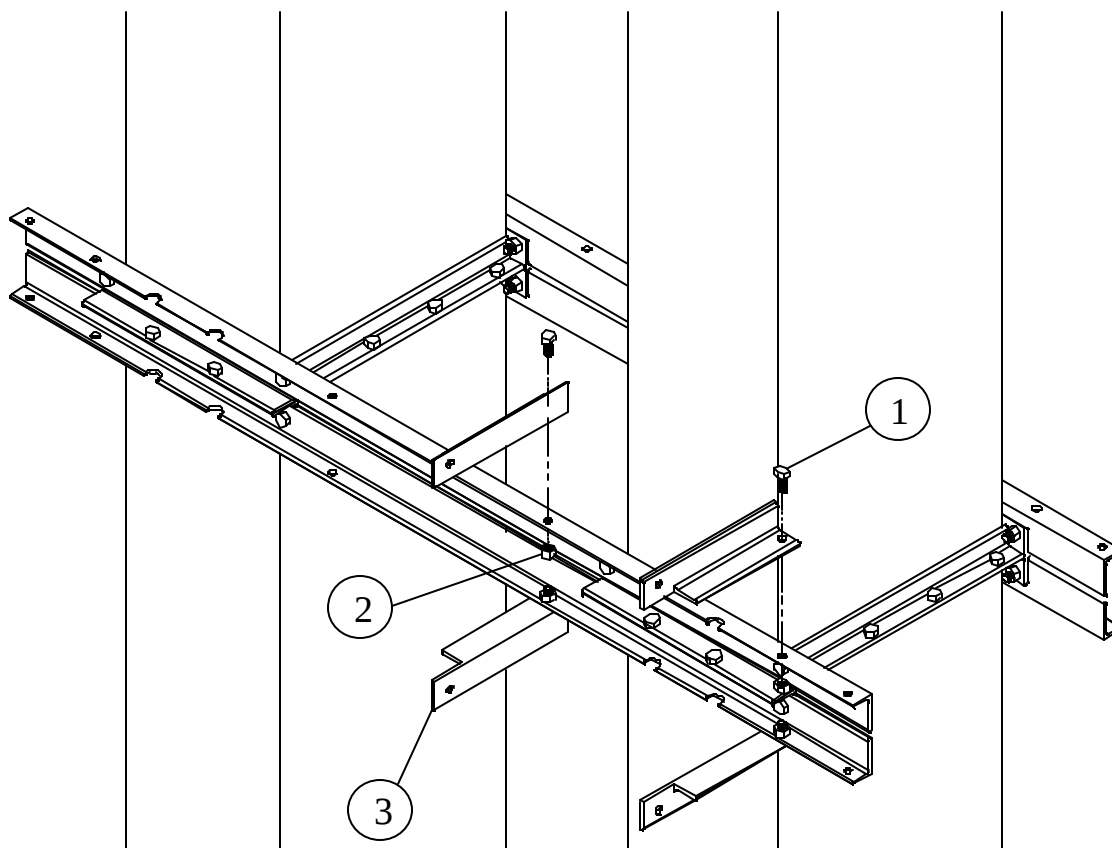
BECT4240 42" Tie Angle Cross Brace



BECT4833 48" Tie Angle Cross Brace

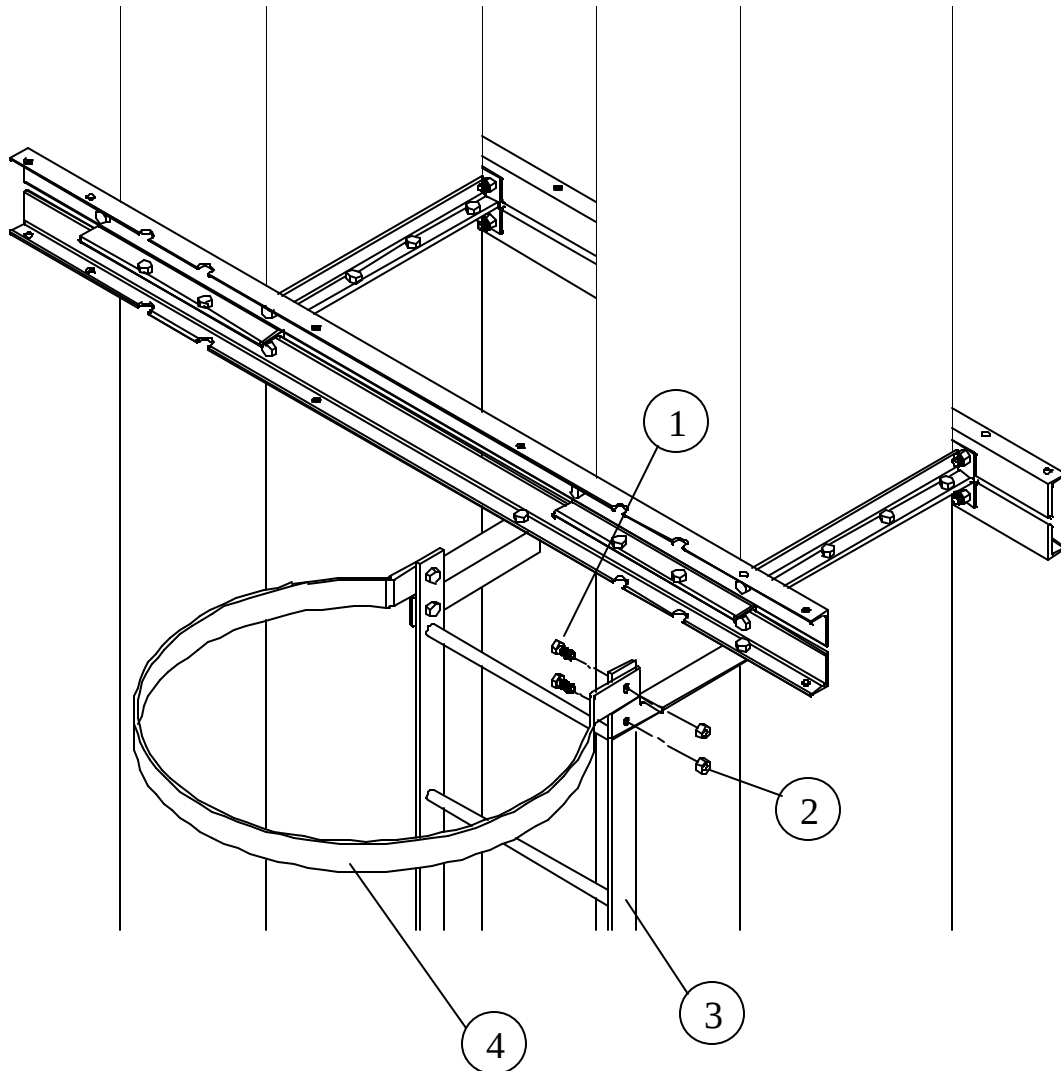


Attach the ladder standoff bracket to the tie angles.



1. 1/2"-13x1" Hex Bolt
2. 1/2"-13 Hex Nut
3. Ladder Standoff Bracket
Left- (be-plat1)
Right- (be-plat2)

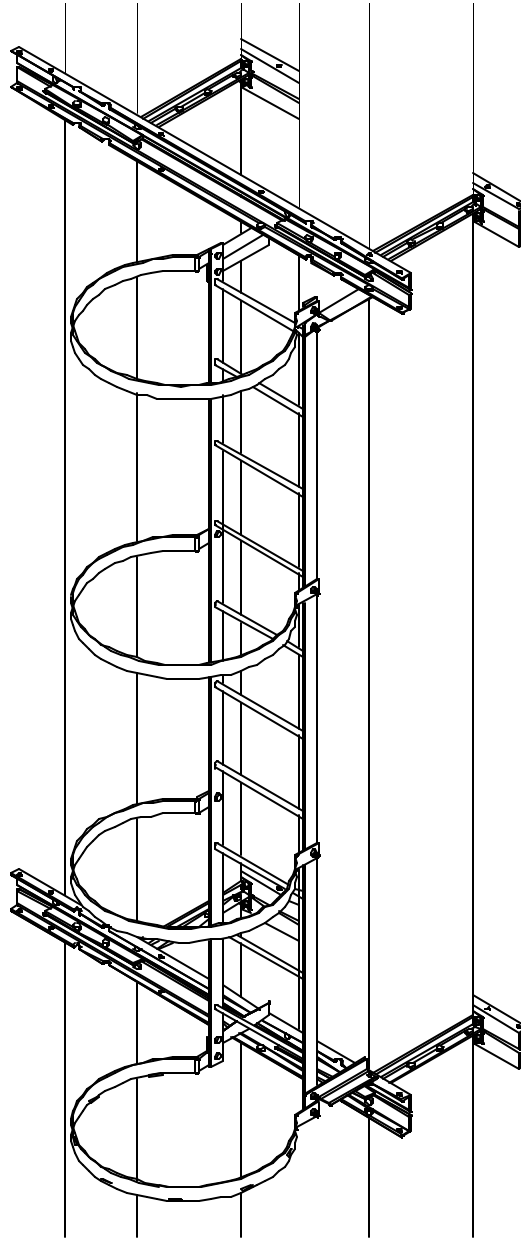
When attaching the ladder to the standoffs the ladder is attached through the second hole down from the end of the ladder. The first hole is for the safety cage hoop to attach through.



1. 1/2"-13x1" Hex Bolt
2. 1/2"-13 Hex Nut
3. 10' Ladder Section** (10foot)
4. 27" Safety Cage Hoop (27hoop)

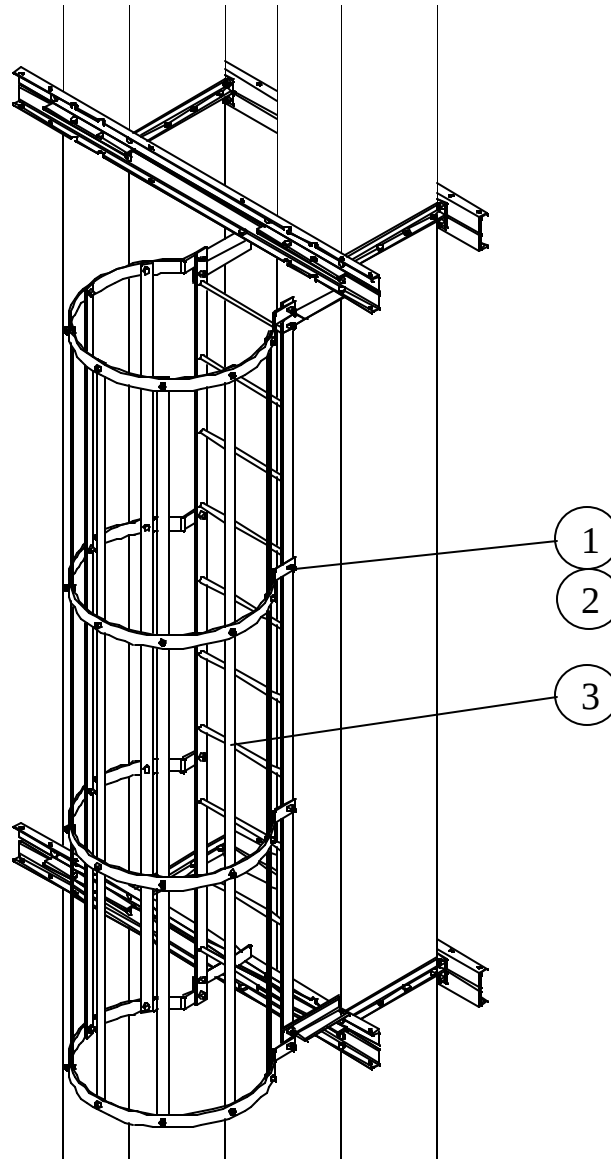
** NOTE: A ten foot section is used anytime the ladder continues on to another section of ladder.
A fourteen foot section is used anytime the ladder extends through any platform deck.

Bolt all safety cage hoops to ladder as shown below.
Leave all bolts loose until the vertical bars are in place
and then tighten all hardware.



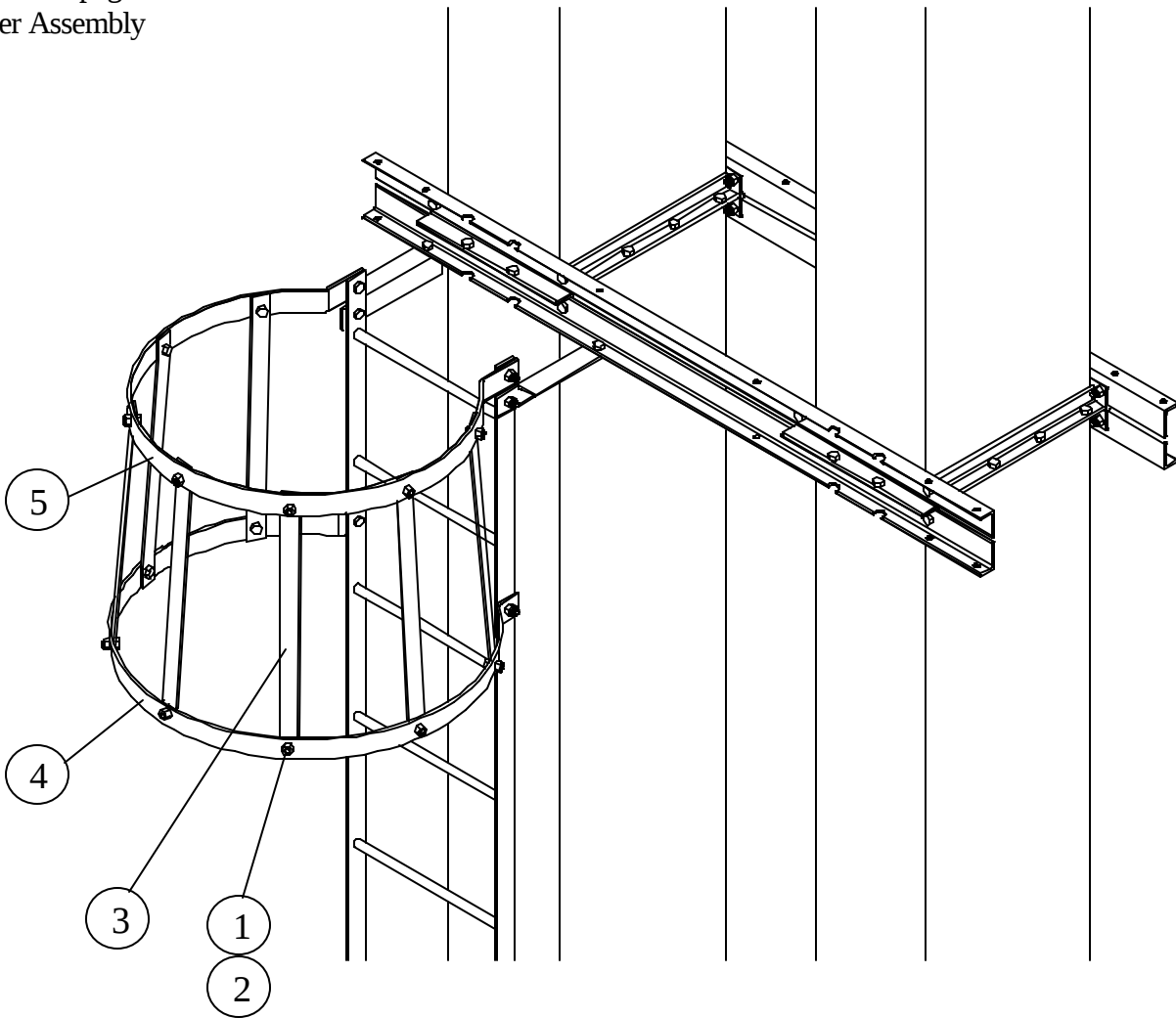
Bolt all safety cage vertical bars to the cage hoops as shown below.

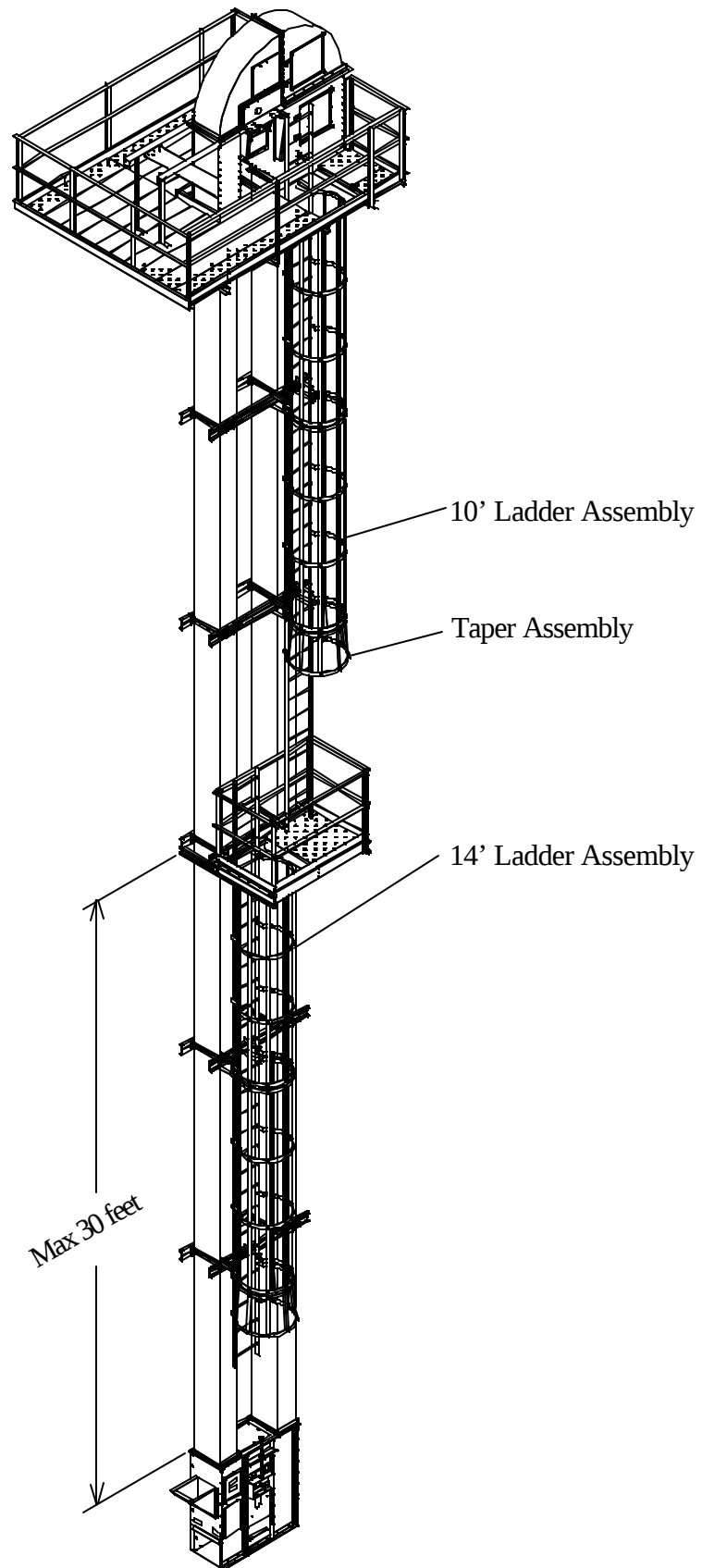

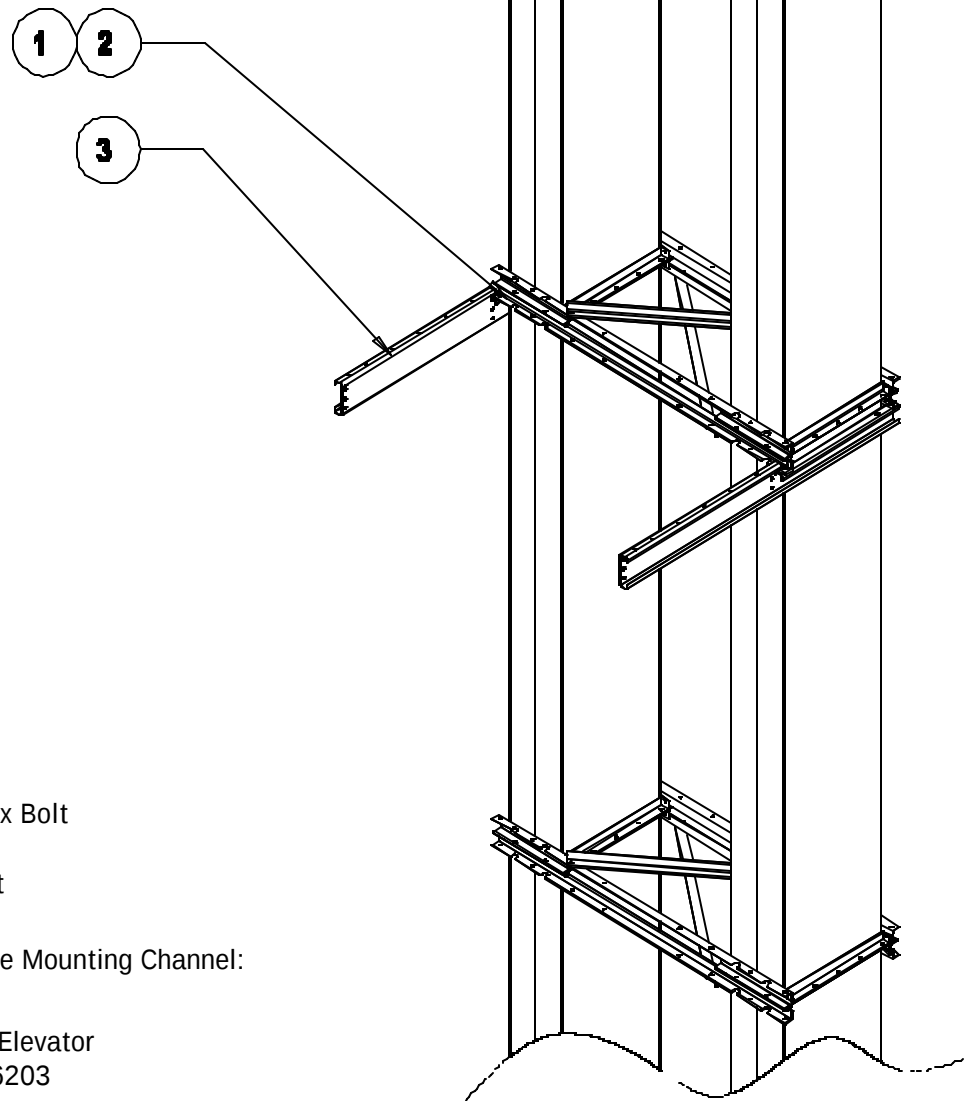


1. 1/2"-13x1" Hex Bolt

REST PLATFORM ASSEMBLY

The first step to assemble the rest platform is to attach the side mounting channels to the tie angles.

Next attach the platform corner posts to the mounting channels as shown below. Leaving hardware loose will help fit other parts in place.

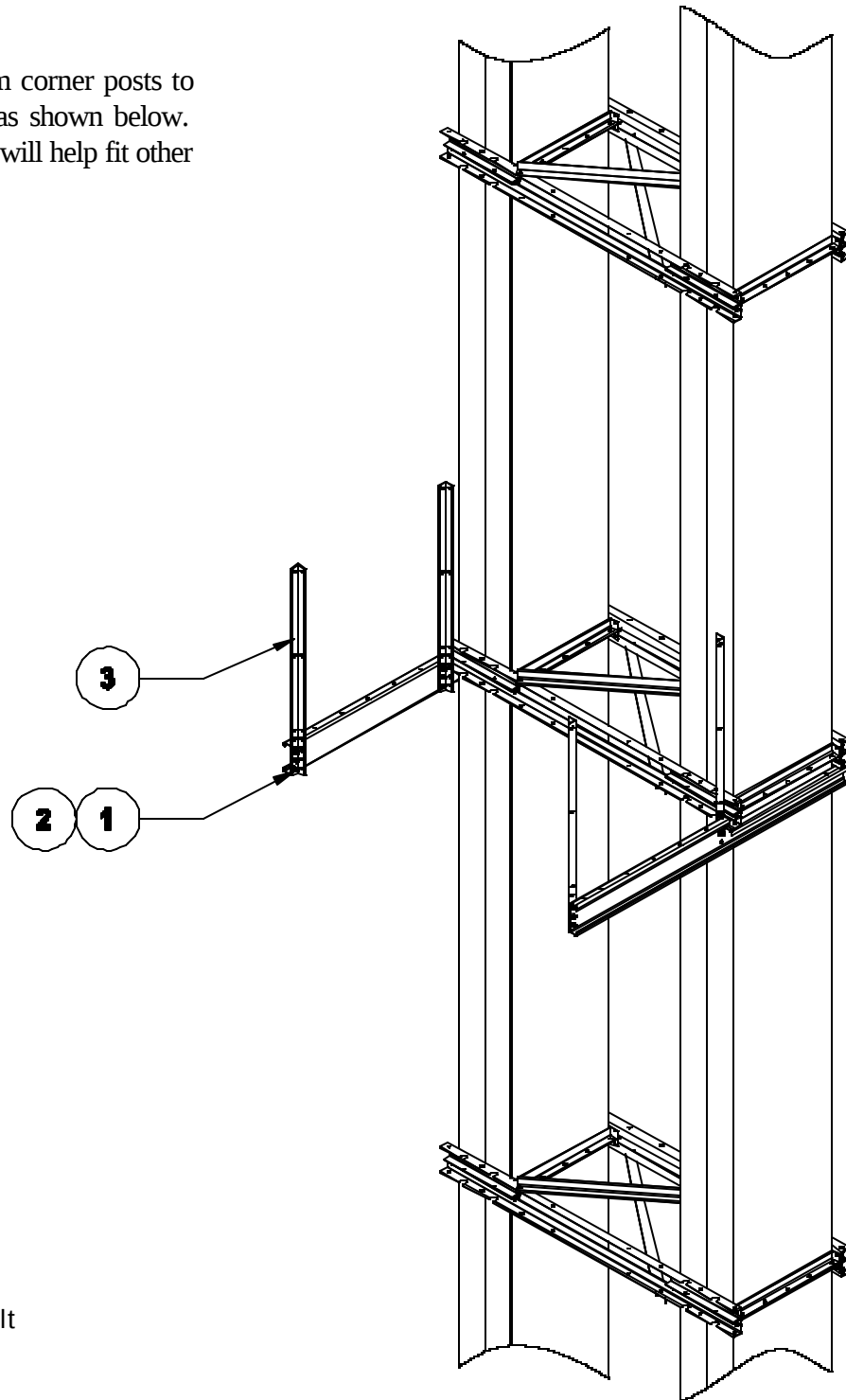
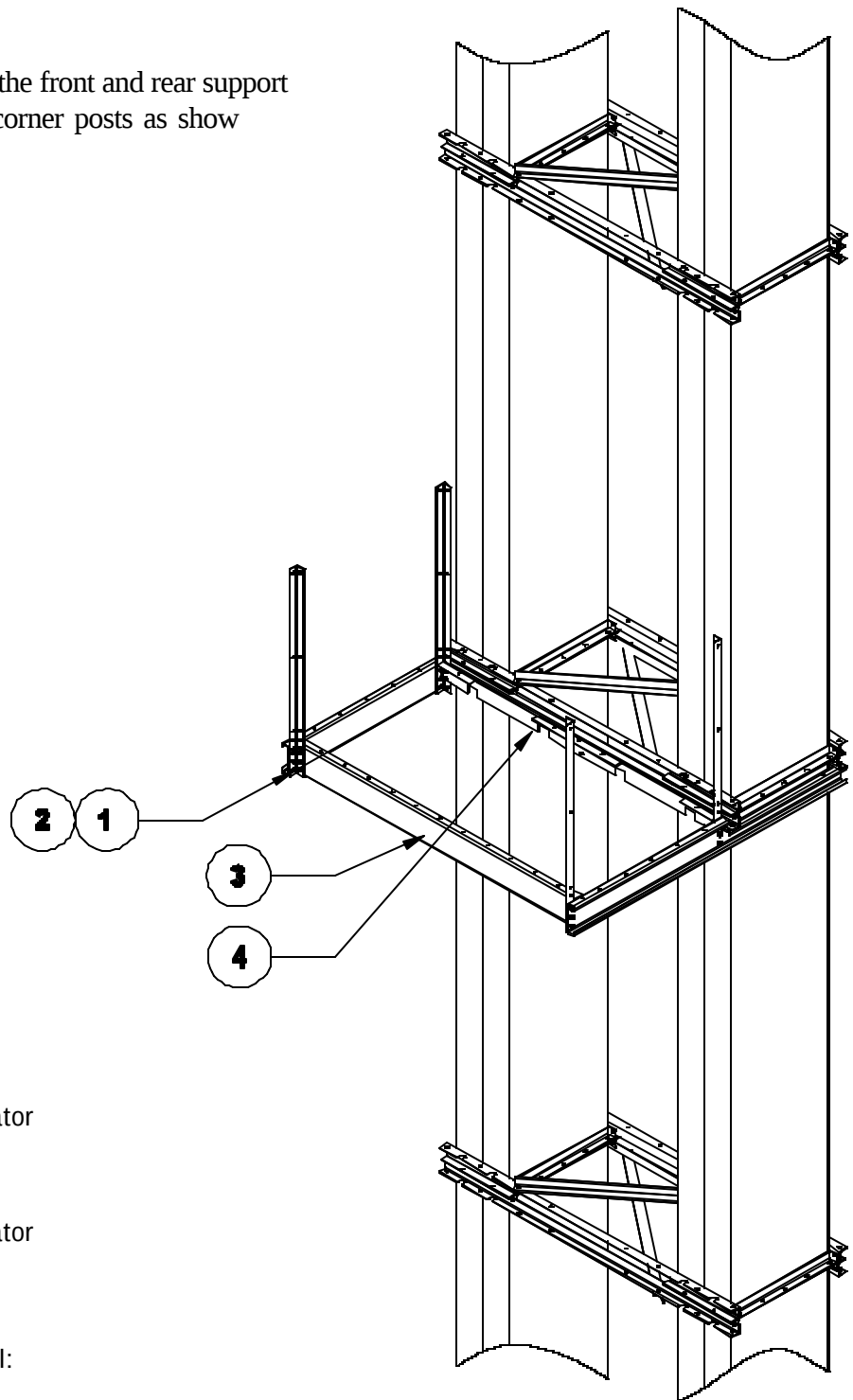

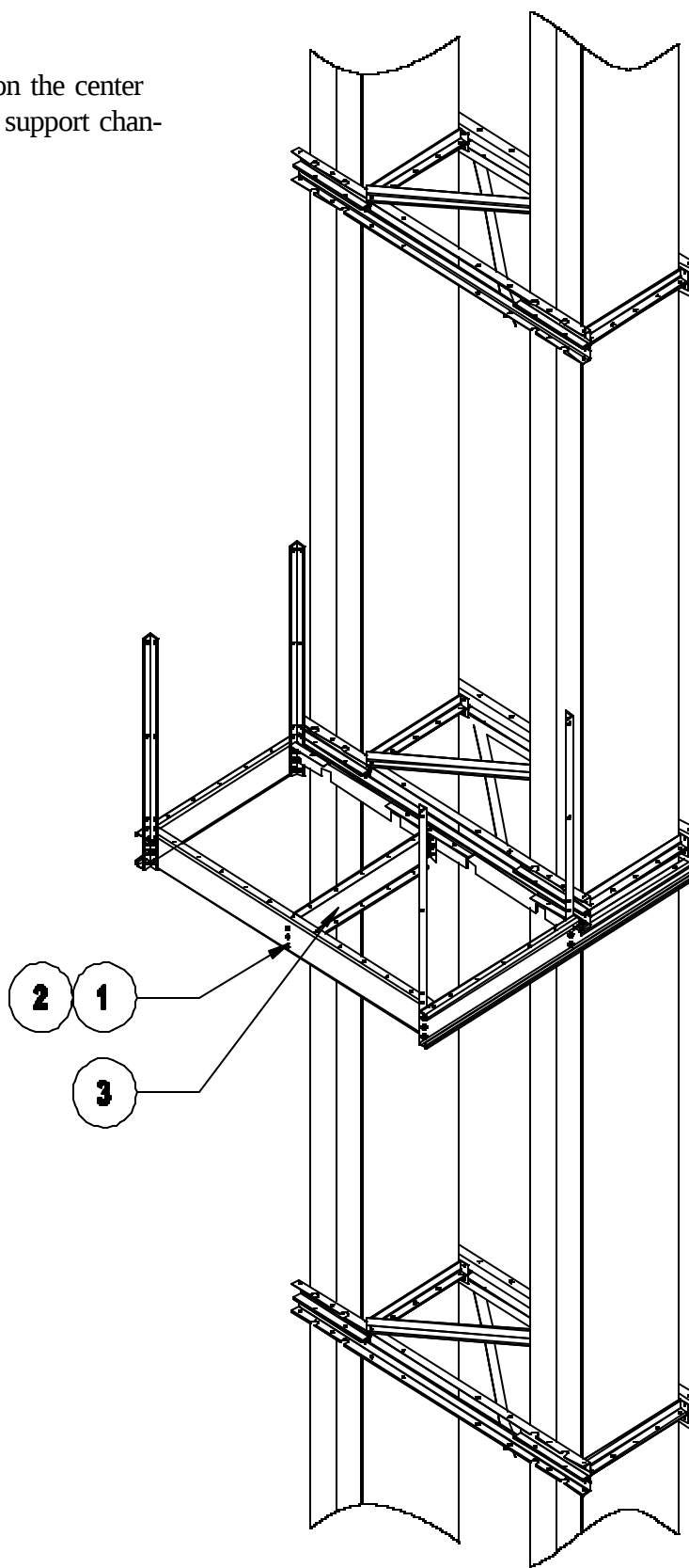

To complete the support frame bolt on the center support channel to the front and rear support channel.



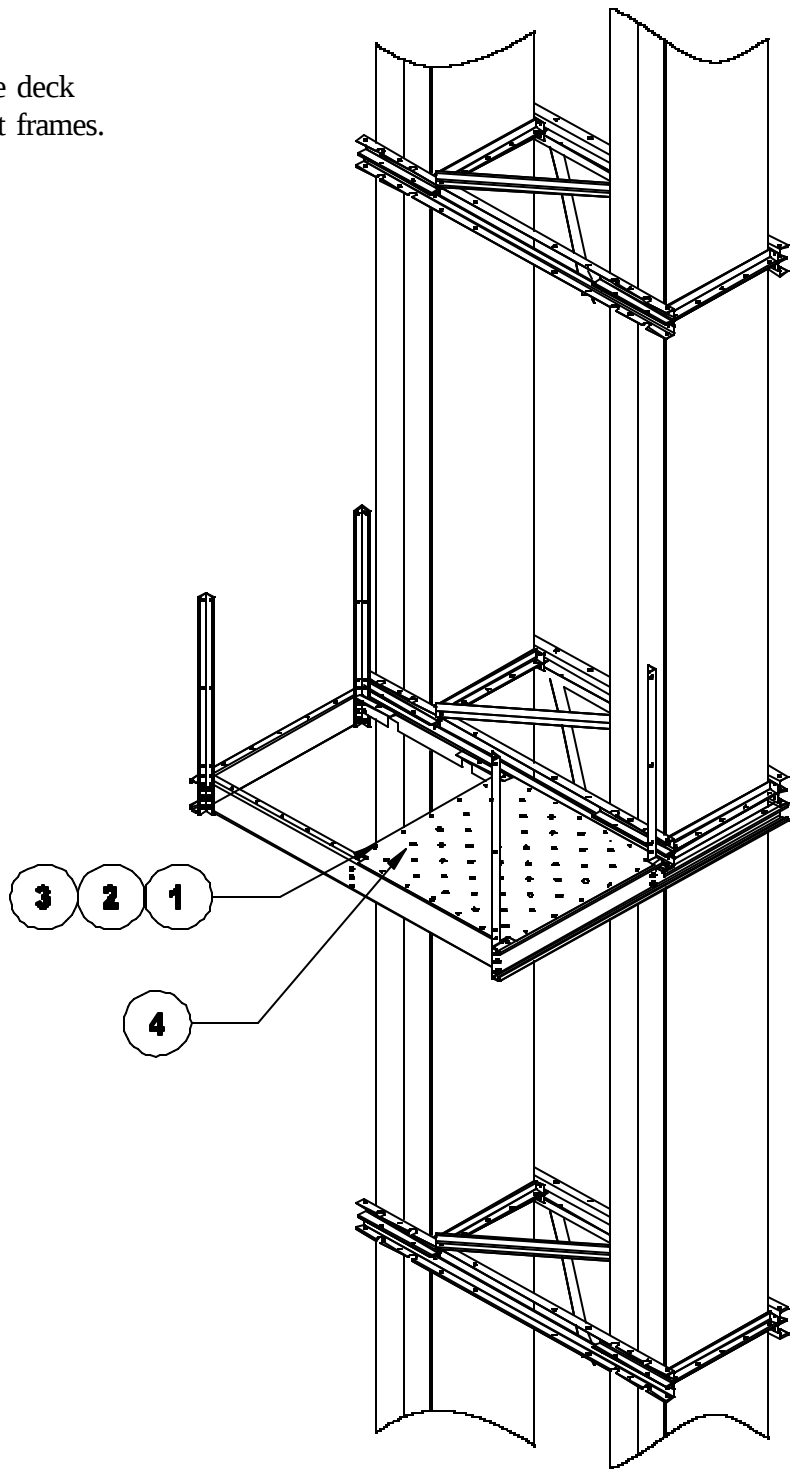

**This setup shows a left side step off. For a right side step off rotate the middle support channel and shift the floor plate.

Using the 1/4" hardware, bolt the deck plate to the mounting and support frames.

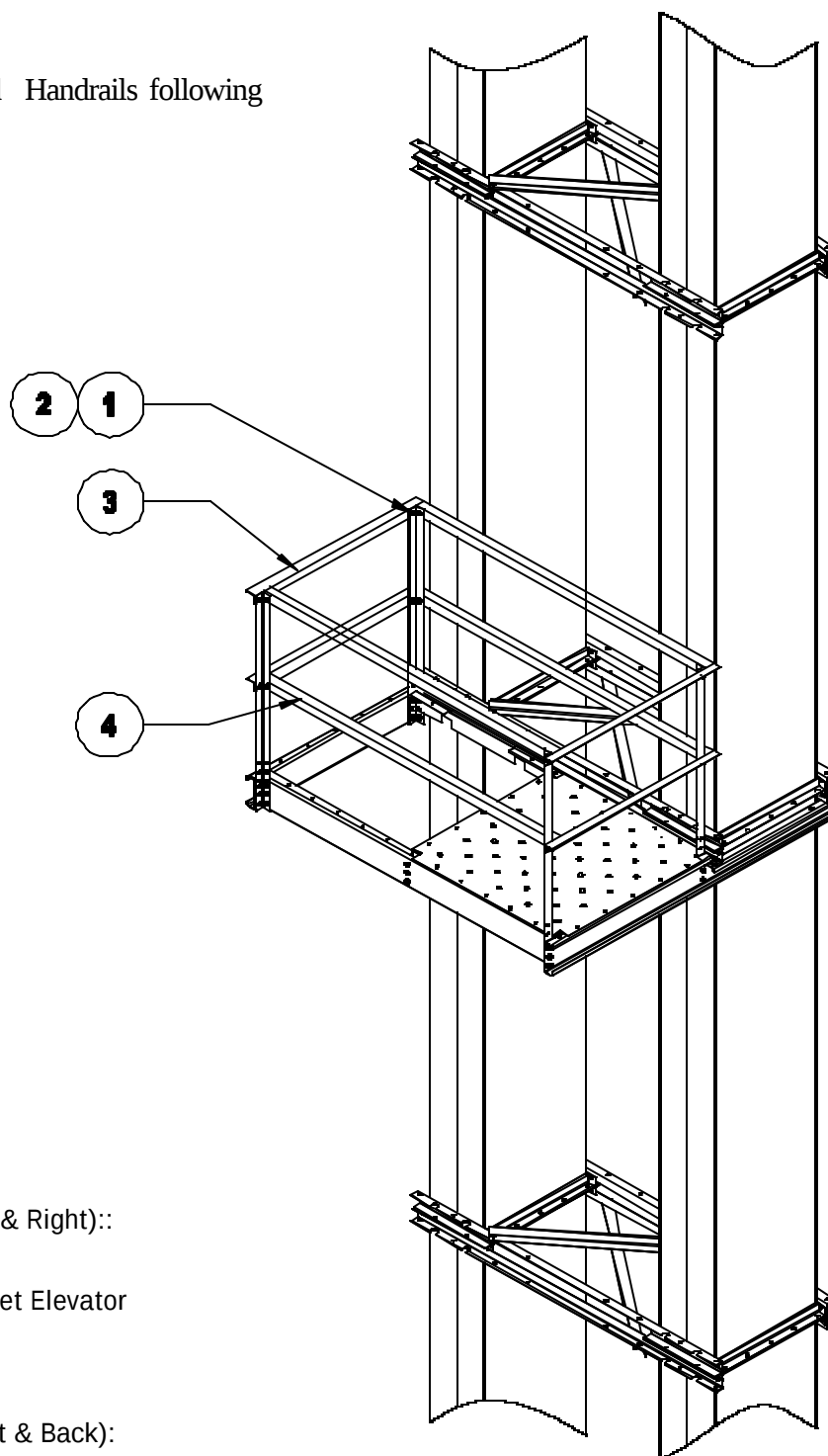

Bucket Elevator 14' Ladder Assembly at Head Service Platform

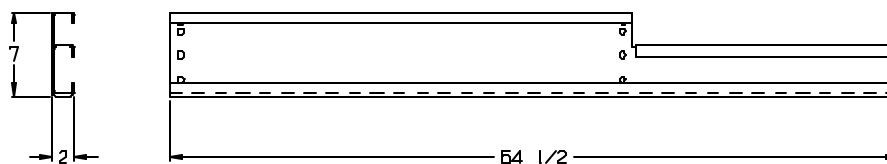
